



# Game Maize

## A consistent performing later maturing maize

- Game maize planted and established correctly provides excellent shooting cover
- Later maturity
- Strong stems that give excellent resistance to lodging
- Highly disease resistant
- Unfolding leaves to provide a good canopy
- Stay green characteristics with excellent early vigour
- Consistent in all conditions
- The seed is treated with Mesurol and Thiaram.



### WHY USE GAME COVER

- Bird habitats can vary from entirely feed to totally cover, from single year crops to semi permanent grass based covers, offer feed, cover or both
- Game cover crops provide a wide range provide habitat for game and farmland birds
- Mixtures and crops are available along with bespoke mixtures on request

### ESSENTIAL INFORMATION

It may be advisable to have your soil analysed and ask one of our specialists to visit your shoot. To encourage wild UK birds it's best to consider a broad range of seed bearing crops.

Establishing a mix takes time and but it's worth the effort. Ask the farmer/landowner about fertilizers, previous crops and soil types.

Use farmyard manure wherever possible – especially on set-aside land.
