



## Game Cover Kale & Quinoa

### A traditional mixture of species specially selected for their feed and cover qualities

- Quinoa produces seed heads at the top of the stem, which shed steadily throughout the game season
- Quinoa seed is a highly palatable source of high protein feed
- Kale gives a winter hardy canopy, much loved by pheasants
- The kale is treated with Cruiser which provides protection from flea beetle attack
- Sow at 3kg/acre



#### WHY USE GAME COVER

- Bird habitats can vary from entirely feed to totally cover, from single year crops to semi permanent grass based covers, offer feed, cover or both
- Game cover crops provide a wide range provide habitat for game and farmland birds

#### ESSENTIAL INFORMATION

It may be advisable to have your soil analysed and ask one of our specialists to visit your shoot. To encourage wild UK birds it's best to consider a broad range of seed bearing crops.

Establishing a mix takes time and but it's worth the effort. Ask the farmer/landowner about fertilizers, previous crops and soil types.

Use farmyard manure wherever possible – especially on set-aside land.
