## Good quality economy perennial rye grass

Verdi has been a well known reliable perennial rye grass for many years now. The variety can be applied in all climate areas for sports and landscape purposes. Verdi shows up a nice winter colour in the moderate climate areas and is able to green up fairly fast after winter. The colour is medium dark which makes it a good variety for southern Europe. Disease tolerance (rust, leaf spot) of Verdi is high.
